T-shirt is included with camp attendance

Please note: Only \$100.00 is refundable if cancellation occurs after 6/20/08. T-shirt size indicated on the application will only be guaranteed for applications before 6/20/08. After that date an alternate size may be substituted.

Registration form must be signed on registration and medical treatment approval lines by parent/guardian! Your signature must be **notorized!** A **copy of your medical insurance card** must be submitted this year!

SNACK SHOP- Your child's Snack Shack money can be included in your Registration Check this year. Indicate the amount on your registration form. This will speed up registration! If sending Snack Shack money to camp with your child, make check out to NWIL District. Please place money or check in an envelope with name and amount on front of envelope. Snack Shop is normally open twice daily. All snack shop money is turned in for credit at Registration to guard against loss. Any money not spent, whether sent in with registration or received at camp, can be returned to the camper at the **conclusion** of camp. \$2-\$4 /day is an avg. figure to use for snacks. \$10-\$20 for the week. Camp Souvenirs are sold also at the Snack Shack.

There will be Express Checkin this year for those with Snack Shack funds turned in with registration fees and Lice checks done before arriving.

Registration is on first received - first confirmed basis. We reserve the right to limit camp size.

CAMP INFORMATION

Bring to Camp:

Bedding – a sheet is required to cover mattress even if using a sleeping bag! Each child must bring one!

Bring Clothes to wear for:

Athletics / Cool evenings/ clean clothes for chapel
Modest swimwear – two piece bathing suits must be covered with T-shirt

PJ's and robe/cover up for going to showers

Old shoes/clothes – some wet/muddy activities

Don't Forget:

Towels/Washclothes

Toothpaste/Toothbrush

Soap/shampoo/Deodorant

TWO sets of clothing/day recommended

Please pack siblings separately!

This is a CO-ED Camp – There will be all boys and all girls activities as well. Campers will be in cabins by grades 2-4th graders and preteens 5-6th grade due to separate pre-teen activities on some evenings.

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR PASTORS, PARENTS & CAMPERS

This camp is organized by the NWIL District Church of the Nazarene and we do our best to adhere to its biblical principles and seek to impart these vital truths in all the things we do. We have the best interest at heart for our youth, and want God's best for them in this week of camp.

Therefore, the following guidelines are respectfully required of each camper and participant:

BASIC IMPORTANT RULES

We are confident that our campers will not bring fireworks, knives, tobacco or drugs, for they will not be allowed.

We are confident that our **campers will not bring** radios, CD players, mp-3's, electronic games, TV's, **cell phones** or like items for they will not be allowed.

No food or drink is allowed in dorms, gym, or tabernacle. Food or drink found in these areas will be removed.

State regulations require each member to cover the mattress with a sheet even if using a sleeping bag.

Dress code: Shoes are to be worn at all times. Appropriate shorts may be worn for athletics and recreation. Campers are to wear appropriate attire to chapel.

We are confident that our young people will conduct themselves in a wholesome manner, for immoral conduct, vulgarity or profanity will not be tolerated. Any physical damage to camp property is the financial responsibility of the offender!

Campers are not allowed to make phone calls except with the permission of the camp director.

For protection of our campers and workers, once camp starts until closing, only campers and workers will be allowed on the campgrounds. Anyone else must have the approval of the camp director.

Cabins are often left unlocked during the day. Please do not bring anything to camp that your would normally keep locked up.

If your child chooses not to be a part of the scheduled program and/or disobeys the rules, you will be expected to provide immediate transportation home.
